

Rajapruk University Announcement Regarding Scholarships and Qualifications for Scholarship Recipients of Rajapruk University, Academic Year B.E. 2564 (A.D. 2021)

In order to ensure the smooth and efficient administration of undergraduate, graduate, and disability scholarships for Rajapruk University students, and pursuant to the authority vested in the Private Higher Education Institutions Act B.E. 2546 (A.D. 2003), as amended by the Amendment Act (No. 2) B.E. 2550 (A.D. 2007), Chapter 3, Section 43, the President hereby announces the "Scholarships and Qualifications for Scholarship Recipients of Rajapruk University, Academic Year B.E. 2564 (A.D. 2021)" as follows:

Article 1: Name of the Announcement

This announcement shall be referred to as the "Rajapruk University Announcement Regarding Scholarships and Qualifications for Scholarship Recipients at Rajapruk University, Academic Year B.E. 2564 (A.D. 2021)."

Article 2: Scholarship Levels of Rajapruk University

Rajapruk University offers two levels of scholarships: undergraduate and graduate, corresponding to the academic programs offered by the university.

Article 3: Single Degree Scholarship

Scholarships are awarded for a single degree program. In the case of students enrolled in a dual degree program, the scholarship will only be considered for the first degree program for which they applied.

Article 4: Types of Scholarships and Qualifications for Undergraduate Student

4.1 Academic Excellence Scholarship

Eligibility: Full-time undergraduate students entering their second semester must maintain a cumulative GPAX of at least 4.00 and be enrolled in a minimum of 18 credit hours each semester to be eligible for this scholarship.

Benefits: Successful applicants will receive a waiver of tuition fees. If the student maintains a 4.00 GPA, the scholarship will be renewed for their second, third, and fourth years.

Additional Requirements: Students must maintain good conduct as certified by their academic advisor, program chairperson, and dean.

4.2 Financial Need Scholarship

Eligibility: Full-time undergraduate students who demonstrate financial need may apply for this scholarship.

Approval Process: Applicants must obtain approval from their academic advisor, program chairperson, dean, and the university president.

4.3 Disaster Relief Scholarship

Eligibility: Full-time undergraduate students who have been affected by a natural disaster may apply for this scholarship.

Approval Process: Applicants must undergo an evaluation process involving their academic advisor, program chairperson, dean, and the university president.

4.4 Scholarship for Academic Excellence from Other Educational Institutions
Eligibility: This scholarship is for incoming undergraduate students
who have completed high school (Grade 12), a vocational certificate (Vocational Certificate
Level 3), or an equivalent qualification. Applicants must have a GPA of at least 3.00 and a
recommendation from their high school counselor or principal. Final selection is made by
the university.

4.5 Good Conduct and Diligence Scholarship

Eligibility: This scholarship is for incoming undergraduate students with a GPA of at least 2.00. Applicants must be recommended by their high school counselor (one student per school).

4.6 General Scholarship for External Candidates

Eligibility: This scholarship is open to individuals who have not yet completed a bachelor's degree and are currently employed in a government or private sector organization for at least two years. Applicants must have a good conduct record and demonstrate a strong work ethic. They must be recommended by their supervisor or employer.

4.7 Scholarships for Athletes, Special Talents, Outstanding Activities, Dance, Music, and Other Activities

Eligibility: Applicants for these scholarships must have completed high school (Grade 12) or a vocational certificate (Vocational Certificate Level 3). The applicant must submit a certification letter from the educational institution they are currently enrolled in or their affiliated organization. For current university students, they must be nominated by their team coach or the head of the relevant unit depending on the type of scholarship.

4.8 Scholarships for Academic Excellence and Outstanding Activities for Transfer Students in Higher Vocational Certificate Programs at Tangtrongchit Affiliated Institutions

Eligibility: Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.50 and a proven record of involvement in extracurricular activities while studying at their current institution. They must also have a good conduct record and a recommendation from the head of their current institution.

4.9 Dependents of Rajapruk University and Tangtrongchit Affiliated Institutions Employees Scholarship

Eligibility: This scholarship is available to the legitimate children of employees of Rajapruk University and Tangtrongchit Affiliated Institutions who have been employed for at least three years. Applicants must have a recommendation from their parent's supervisor or employer.

4.10 Employees of Rajapruk University and Tangtrongchit Affiliated Institutions Scholarship

Eligibility: This scholarship is open to employees of Rajapruk University and Tangtrongchit Affiliated Institutions who have a good conduct record and have been employed for at least three years. Applicants must be recommended by the chairman of the executive board of the Tangtrongchit affiliated institution.

4.11 Disability Scholarship

Eligibility: Applicants must have a good academic record and a disability certificate issued in accordance with the law. They must not be receiving a disability scholarship from the Office of the Permanent Secretary for Higher Education, Science, Research, and Innovation.

4.12 Other Scholarships

Eligibility: Scholarships not specified in this announcement will be nsidered and approved by the university president.

Article 5: Types of Scholarships and Qualifications for Graduate Students 5.1 Academic Excellence Scholarship

Eligibility: Applicants must have completed their undergraduate studies in the same academic year they are applying for the graduate program. They must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.50 and be a top-performing student in their undergraduate program. Applicants must also have a good conduct record and be selected by the Rajapruk University Executive Committee.

5.2 General Scholarship for External Candidates

Eligibility: External applicants must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.50, a good conduct record, and a recommendation from their current employer or supervisor. Final approval rests with the university president.

5.3 Scholarships for Athletes and Special Talents

Eligibility: Applicants must have completed their undergraduate studies and have demonstrated outstanding achievements at the provincial or national level. They must also contribute actively to university activities.

5.4 Employees of Rajapruk University and Tangtrongchit Affiliated Institutions Scholarship

Eligibility: Applicants must be employees of Rajapruk University or Tangtrongchit Affiliated Institutions. They must have a good conduct record, at least three years of service, and a recommendation from their supervisor. Scholarship recipients may be required to repay the scholarship under the terms set by their employer.

5.4 Other Scholarships

Eligibility: Scholarships not specified in this announcement will be considered and approved by the President.

Article 6: Types of Scholarship Benefits

There are four types of scholarship benefits:

6.1 Credit Hour Waiver

Benefit: Scholarship recipients will have their tuition fees waived for each semester.

Additional Fees: Other fees, such as a semester fee of 8,500 baht for the first semester and 6,500 baht for subsequent semesters, will still apply.

6.2 Educational Expenses Waiver

Benefit: Scholarship recipients will have their fees waived for items such as equipment and other miscellaneous fees charged by the university each semester.

6.3 Partial Scholarship

Benefit: Scholarship recipients will pay half of the total tuition and other fees such as equipment and miscellaneous items charged by the university each semester.

6.4 Housing Allowance

Benefit: Scholarship recipients may receive a housing allowance to cover the cost of on-campus or off-campus accommodation. The amount of the allowance will be determined by the university based on an agreement with the student.

Article 7: Duration of Scholarships

7.1 Scholarships for Undergraduate and Graduate Programs Based on Program Duration

Duration: Scholarship benefits as outlined in Article 5 will be provided for the duration of the specified degree program.

Termination: If a student fails to complete the program within the stipulated timeframe, they will be responsible for all subsequent tuition and fees.

7.2 Scholarships for Undergraduate and Graduate Programs with a Fixed

Duration

Duration: Scholarship benefits as outlined in Article 5 will be provided for a specified number of semesters or academic years.

Termination: After the scholarship period ends, the student will be responsible for all tuition and fees.

7.3 Eligibility Period

Limitation: Scholarships must be applied for and awarded within the specified academic year.

Article 8: Scholarship Cancellation

8.1 Successful Completion of the Program

Cancellation: The scholarship will be terminated upon the successful completion of the specified degree program.

8.2 Failure to Meet Eligibility Requirements

Cancellation: The scholarship will be terminated if the student no longer meets the eligibility criteria outlined in Article 6.

8.3 Poor Academic Performance

Cancellation: The scholarship will be terminated if the student's GPA falls below 2.00 at the undergraduate level or below 3.00 at the graduate level.

8.4 Financial Responsibility: Students who receive an F grade in any course or enroll in remedial courses will be responsible for paying the associated tuition fees. The university may also reserve the right to terminate the scholarship.

8.5 Withdrawal or Death

Cancellation: The scholarship will be terminated if the student withdraws from the program, passes away, or in other cases as stipulated by university regulations.

Article 9: Deadline for Scholarship Applications

9.1 Current Students

Deadline: Current students can submit their scholarship applications between 1st January and 30th June of each academic year.

9.2 Students with a 4.00 GPA

Deadline: Students who achieve a 4.00 GPA in a semester may submit their applications within 30 days of the start of the following semester. Applications submitted after this deadline will not be considered.

9.3 External Students

Deadline: External students can submit their scholarship applications between 1st January and 30th May of each academic year.

9.4 Athletic and Other Scholarships

Deadline: Applications for athletic and other specific scholarships must be submitted between 1st January and 30th June of each academic year.

9.5 Late Applications

Decision: Applications submitted after the specified deadlines will be considered at the discretion of the university president.

Article 10: Required Documents for Scholarship Application

10.1 Letter of Recommendation: A letter of recommendation from the student's previous institution, signed by an authorized administrator.

10.2 Scholarship Certificate: A scholarship certificate issued by Rajapruk University and signed by the President.

Article 11: Scholarship Non-Transferability

Undergraduate and graduate scholarships are non-transferable. They cannot be exchanged for cash or transferred to another person.

Article 12: Scholarship Committee

The President shall appoint a scholarship committee to oversee the scholarship process. This committee will be responsible for reviewing scholarship applications starting from the second semester of the B.E. 2563 (A.D. 2020) academic year.

Article 13: Finality of Scholarship Decisions

All scholarship decisions made under this announcement are final and at the sole discretion of Rajapruk University. Once a decision has been made, no further appeal or claim shall be entertained.
